Galilee

Western Galilee - Caesarea, Haifa, Akko and Rosh HaNikra

Travel up the Mediterranean coast, to the city of Caesarea, which was constructed under Herod and named after the Roman Emperor, Caesar. Visit the remains of the ancient city's archaeological excavations, the Roman theater, the hippodrome, and the Roman Temple. Continue north passing through Haifa, view of the breathtaking Baha'i Shrine and gardens. On to Rosh HaNikra, descend by cable car into the network of limestone grottos. Stop for a visit at Acre (Akko), the largest Crusader city in the country.

Nazareth & the Sea of Galilee

Travel up the Mediterranean coast, through the Valley of Armageddon, towards Nazareth. View of the Mount of Precipitation. Visit the Church of Annunciation, then on to visit the Church of Saint Joseph built on the site where Jesus' father, Joseph, had his carpentry. On to the Sea of Galilee, passing by Cana, where Jesus turned water into wine. Visit Capernaum, located on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, at the foot of the Mount of Beatitudes. See the home of Peter and the Church of the Multiplication at the site of Tabgha. Travel along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, viewing the Golan Heights. Pass the city of Tiberias, named after the Roman Emperor Tiberius. Reach the southern region of the Sea of Galilee to visit the Jordan River site, where Jesus may have been baptized. View of Mount Tabor, the site of The Transfiguration, on the way back.



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Sea of Galilee, Magdala & Cana

Drive up north to the region of the Sea of Galilee. Stop in Magdala, the birth place of Mary Magdalene. See the remains of an ancient Biblical era fishing village, the ruins of a Second Temple period synagogue and the ongoing excavations. On to Kibbutz Ginosar, to view the frame of an ancient fishing boat from the time of Jesus, at the Beit Yigal Allon Museum. The tour continues along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, viewing the Mount of Beatitudes, on to Kfar Cana, the site of Biblical Cana, where Jesus performed the first of his miracles and turned water into wine at a wedding feast. Visit the Wedding Church of Cana.

Golan Heights Tour

Travel up the Mediterranean coast, through the Valley of Armageddon towards the Sea of Galilee. Cross the Jordan River, and begin the ascent to the Golan Heights through Hamat Gader- a popular spa destination. Continue through the lush green countryside to reach the Shalom Observatory, for a panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee. Travel to Katzrin, visit partially restored excavations of a village from the Mishnah and Talmud periods, including a synagogue, houses and an oil press. See the black basalt rock formations, evidence of former volcanic activity in the Golan Heights. Continue to Mount Bental to see remains of Syrian fortifications, bunkers and trenches, view of Syria.
